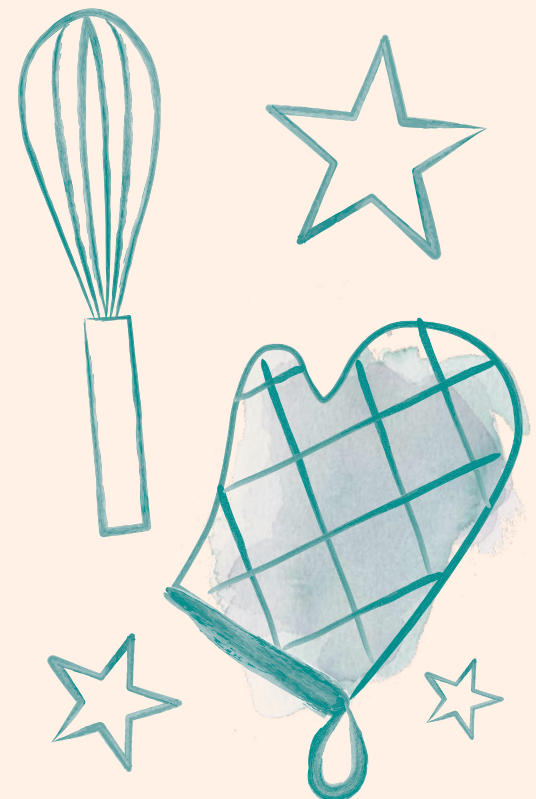
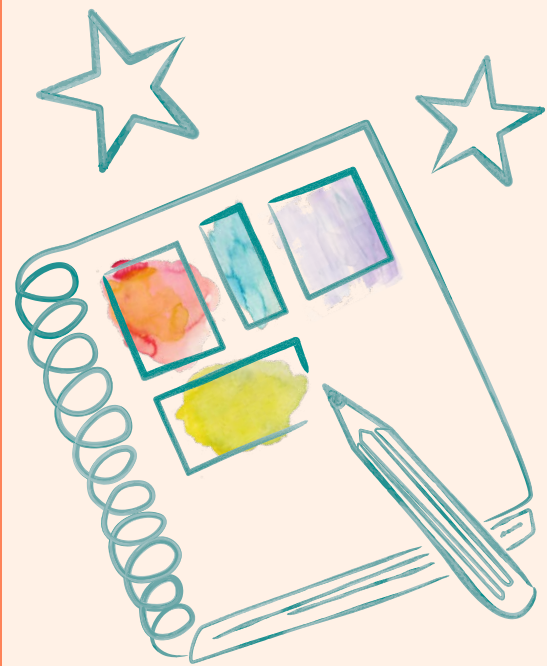
# WEEK SIX
